Mrs Marriott News Update:

Thank you for all the hats and water bottles keeping the children safe in the sun and hot weather. It has been particularly hot and staff are reminding children to drink regularly and fill up water bottles if they need to. We have been using the outdoor areas, but making use of the shady parts and utilising indoor activities when the sun has been very strong.

As usual there is lots of wonderful learning going on across the school:

Children in Early Years have been busy thinking about transition. Reception children are welcoming the Pre-school children into their classroom to support them being ready to start school. Mrs Jermy and I enjoyed touring new and existing parents around the school on Wednesday this week.

Children in KS1 children have been sewing glove puppets as the learning in Design and Technology and are now acting out little shows using them.

Children in LKS2 have been making canopic jars out of clay this week as part of their Big Question on Ancient Egypt.

Children in UKS2 have begun practicing their upcoming production of The Wizard of Oz. In between each practice there are lots of rustling scripts as children begin to learn their lines. We are looking forward to the rehearsals building up to the performances in coming weeks.

The final touches are being added to school reports which are sent out later in the term. You will also receive information early in July about which class your child will be in next year. This comes as a 'stick on the fridge' sheet, with a photo of your child's teacher, which you can refer to across the summer break. A 'move up morning' is planned for in July in which your child can visit their new teacher and spend time as a new class.

There are so many activities which happen across the school like reading, Forest school, clay days and swimming which are made so much more enjoyable for the children due to the additional hands and eyes supporting. A school PTA is beginning to form, so please do get in touch if you think you can help in any way.

Lastly, thank you to everyone across our school community who are reaching out to each other. Many families have mentioned to me this week just how well supported they feel in difficult times by the wider school community. In particular helping with drop off and pick up to school, people on the playground checking in with parents and offering their help.
