At Hemingford Grey Primary School we aim to inspire learning by providing a wide variety of challenges and tasks across the curriculum. Learning will be seamless through pre-learning and reviewing learning both at home and at school. Opportunities for learning will be open ended so that all children can access and complete them. Homework will be monitored and celebrated in school.

Key Stage One and Two will have termly creative projects linked to their theme. This will be set in the form of a key question which relates to the learning that is taking place in class. The project will have a number of suggested responses to encourage children to be as creative as possible and to support them in creating a high quality piece of work.

Children will have a window in which to complete the project which spans either side of half term. Once the project has been returned, children will share it with their class and it will also be displayed at the termly Class Celebration.
