Our KS1 children have given every effort to their SATs papers this week and we are so proud of their efforts.

In assembly this week, I introduced the idea of creating a Queen's Platinum Jubilee time capsule to the children. We are still deciding in how many years we will want the future historians of Hemingford School to open the time capsule. Your child can contribute an A4 sheet of information about themselves. 
