Mrs Marriott News Update:

Welcome back to the last half term of the year.

It has been a busy week which began with a two day Sculpture Workshop for Year 3/4. You will see the wonderful willow sculptures on the wildflower mound as you walk through the main entrance to the playground. The children were so engaged in creating these pieces of collaborative art and are very proud that everyone can share enjoyment of them.

The children were all excited to meet their new teachers yesterday. With lots of sessions over the coming weeks, the children and adults will all get to know each other really well.

Miss Jones and I spent some time in Year 5/6 classrooms looking at the learning and progress of pupils this week. We were so impressed with the high quality of work produced by the pupils and their active engagement in the learning.

Staying Safe! Our KS1 children continue to swim this half term and following a half term of Year 5 swimming, Year 6 will swim this half term. Whilst the school is in receipt of Sports Premium funding from the government, we are prioritising swimming as a skill which all children should have an opportunity to develop. The local area is surrounded by water and so teaching water safety is a high priority. Next year all our pupils in Year 1 -Year 6 will have at least a half term of swimming lessons so that we support this important skill development.
