As Designers we will design and make a moving vehicle. We will use the skills of measuring, cutting, and joining to make sure the vehicle is strong. We will use our scientific knowledge to help us with our designs. We will evaluate our vehicles and suggest improvements.

As Artists we will be investigating artists from South Africa and the Arctic. We will be exploring different palettes of hot and cold colours to create our own paintings of contrasting locations.

As Geographers we will be using geographical vocabulary to make observations and records about our local area before using books, maps and globes to help us locate the British Isles, Europe, Africa and the Arctic. We will also solve challenges outdoors, using our map reading and orienteering skills.



As mathematicians we will be developing our fluency in number and understanding of place value. We will use this knowledge to develop our reasoning skills as well as learning how to add and subtract.



As linguists we will be learning how to speak some Afrikaans.



As Gardeners we will begin to plant our new beds and allotments whilst developing our understanding of the needs of plants.
