Socks and Hahts Plain newy blue, grey, black or white No leggings.

#### Physical Education (PE)

\*For children in Foundation Stage, PE is not a statutory subject and children access opportunities for Physical Development throughout the day. Therefore, PE kit is not required until 11.

\*Children can wear their PE kit to school on PE days.

\*In recognition of health and safety guidence, earnings are not permitted to be worn in PE lessons so should be removed for the day or the lesson. Removal of earnings is best practice as we will not be accepting tape over earnings.
