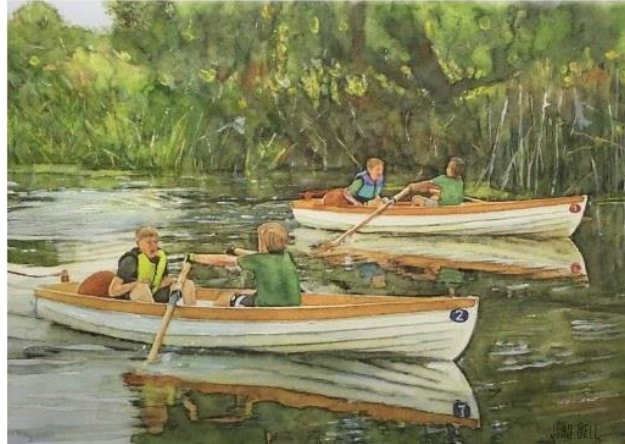


# Hemingford Grey Primary School Newsletter 7th July 2023

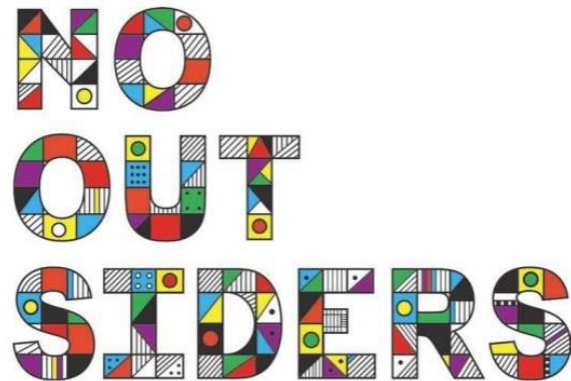
