## Dear families,

After a year of behind the scenes planning and decisions, we are delighted to have officially have the Hemingford Playgroup under school leadership. We have lots of work ahead of us to keep the provision financially viable under school leadership and we are committed to making it a success. Having early years provision is important for our families and the community and important for the early education of the children who attend.

I am writing to update you of a few changes for September. The Playgroup will now become Hemingford Pre-school:



### Uniform (optional)

The uniform will align to our school uniform colour, with navy blue t-shirts and sweatshirts with a logo being available from the <a href="https://www.thegreenschoolshop.co.uk">https://www.thegreenschoolshop.co.uk</a> ready for September. Uniform is not compulsory and children may wear any clothes suitable for a day at pre-school.

## Two and a half year old provision

In order to continue to provide both a high level of care, alongside early years education, we have decided to offer set sessions only, for two and a half year olds from September. This will be for three morning sessions per week. The number of sessions on offer will remain under review from September, whilst we monitor impact of the changes. Limiting provision for two year olds can better enable staff to cater to the developmental needs of the children attending. There will be no offer for wrap around provision until children turn three years old.

### Wrap Around

Wrap Around provision will continue 8-9am and 3-5.30pm Monday to Friday term-time only. This provision is for children aged 3-5 years old, so includes Reception aged children, who are still within the

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Early Years Foundation stage and will benefit from the nurturing environment as they begin school. Charges for this are £5.20 per hour.

### Fees
