

Amount received: £18,320

Planned expenditure:

- Costs for sports coaches to work with all classes across the school and to support in up-skilling teachers. Two way benefit as we also enable young apprentices in St Neots Academy to develop their skills of working with young people. **£15,500**
- 2 hours coaching from Huntingdon gym per week **£2,300**
- 6 days release time for PE co-ordinator **£1110** to co-ordinate competitive sports and entry into tournaments, mentor the coach and games leader.
- Spare PE kit: **£150**
- Cost of school kit for teams: **£550**
- Cost of transport to and from events: **£300**
- Total: **£19,910**

The PE premium has enabled the school to develop key and core skills with our pupils. This has resulted in strong uptake in a range of clubs and success in inter school competitions.
