Amber heat warning: The Met Office has extended an amber heat warning ¹ for Sunday 17 July, Monday 18 July and Tuesday 19 July, as temperatures will build this weekend and early next week for much of England.

The current advice from the local authority/government is that schools are to remain open. The local authority are liaising with the government regularly and we will of course advise you if there any update later on today.

All staff follow these guidelines to keep children safe during extreme heatwave weather:

- Ventilation used throughout school
- Children kept hydrated please ensure water bottles are brought to school (they can regularly refil)
 - Children will not take part in vigorous physical activity
 - Children are encouraged to stay in the shade
 - Please make sure that children have sun cream on and bring hats to school.
